

Student Bursary Policy

From our Policy Statement:

**STUDENT BURSARY PROGRAM: SSI Society for Community Education may grant bursaries to those students who request assistance and are in financial need. The amount of the bursary award will be up to one-half of the stated cost of the course. Raising funds for this initiative will be an ongoing high priority for this Society.
(Revised: 14 September, 2009)**

Instruction to Students

Bursaries are granted on a “first come first served basis”.

Criteria for granting Bursaries includes:

- those whose financial means are limited, or
- where payment of full fees would create a hardship, for example:
 - those who are unemployed or earning low wages
 - single mothers with young children
 - those relying upon social assistance or a disability pension
 - GIS - Guaranteed Income Supplement

The maximum dollar amount of bursaries granted per individual per year is \$100. Bursaries may be granted for up to 1/2 of the cost of the course, contingent on the availability of funds.
